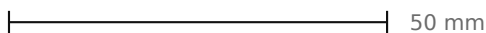


BANGUOJA | Ring size guide

Measure your size at home in 2 minutes

1. CHECK THE PRINT SCALE

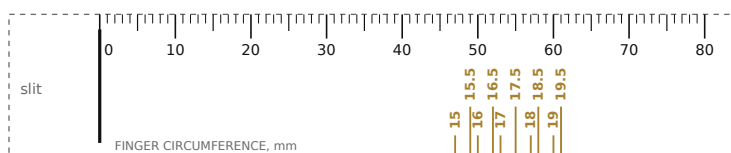
Print at 100 % scale (turn off "Fit to page"). This line must be exactly 50 mm long and the frame must match a bank card.



Bank card (85.6 × 54 mm)

2. PAPER STRIP - IF YOU ARE MEASURING A FINGER

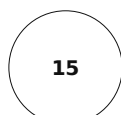
Cut out the strip along the dashed line and cut a slit at the "0" mark. Wrap the strip around the finger where you will wear the ring, slide the end through the slit and pull gently – snug, not tight. The number at the slit is your finger circumference in mm. Gold marks show the BANGUOJA size.

3. CIRCLES - IF YOU HAVE A RING THAT FITS

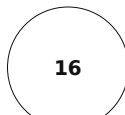
Place the ring over a circle. The right size is when the inner edge of the ring lines up exactly with the circle (the line is visible but does not show outside the ring).

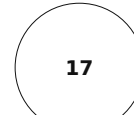

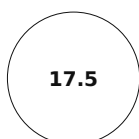

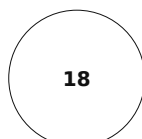

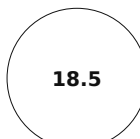

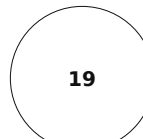

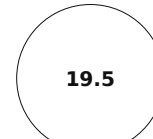

BANGUOJA SIZE	INNER DIAMETER	CIRCUMFERENCE	US	EU	UK
15	15 mm	47 mm	4	47	H½
15.5	15.5 mm	49 mm	4¾	49	I½
16	16 mm	50 mm	5½	50	K
16.5	16.5 mm	52 mm	6	52	L
17	17 mm	53 mm	6½	53	M
17.5	17.5 mm	55 mm	7¾	55	N½

TIPS

- Measure at the end of the day – fingers are slightly larger in the evening.
- If your knuckle is wider than the base of the finger, measure both and choose in between.
- Between two sizes? Go for the larger one.
- Wide bands need about half a size more.
